

Draft Annual Plan Out for Consultation

Contained in this Draft Annual Plan Consultation Document are proposed changes to the work programme and budgets, and key considerations for Council to address during 2017/18. One of the decisions to be made is whether or not Council should develop a policy for shops to have the option of trading on Easter Sunday. However, before we decide, we really want to hear from you and what you think.

In 2017/18 our main priority continues to be the upgrade and maintenance of core infrastructure for water supply, wastewater and stormwater, ensuring the network remains resilient, safe and cost effective. This work programme is reflected in an average district wide rate increase of 3.8%, lower than that forecast in the Long Term Plan at 5%.

The third year of our Long Term Plan is about making sure we continue to deliver on our commitment to maintain existing services, invest in required infrastructure renewal, and spend wisely on new infrastructure needed to support the anticipated further growth of the district.
